Pastor's Message

My house is officially a construction site. My father and I are putting in the work for a full kitchen remodel. New tile floors, new counter top, some new cabinets, new backsplash and more. We began by trying to get the cabinets where the countertop would go ready for the new counter top, but when we began it became apparent that those cabinets would need to be replaced. Since we were pulling up the cabinets we decided we may as well begin the process of pulling up the old floor. What we discovered was that there were actually four floors on the ground, the, newest particle board floor was sitting on top of 3 linoleum floors so we pulled them all out, took out all the nails and got the floor down to the floor boards. What I didn't realize going into the process was how labor intensive getting the old floors out would be. At the same time however it was clearly a very important process. By taking things apart down to the base we will be able to build from a sturdy base, from the ground up. I think a lot of people know that feeling from projects they have been a part of, sometimes you need to go all the way down to the foundation of something, to build back up on that sturdy base. I think that Jesus knew that we would relate to that image, to that feeling.

Mission Message

Chhani Marandi used to be a domestic worker. She is 24, lives in Nepal, and always dreamed of being a health care professional, inspired by her father's health problems. He died when she was 5, and her older siblings had to leave school and work to support the family. Chhani herself started to do domestic work in third grade to pay for her own education, eventually graduating from 10th grade. Then she heard about a scholarship program from the Lutheran Community Welfare Society, a partner of Lutheran World Federation in Nepal. This is one of many projects supported by ELCA World Hunger that create opportunities for women.

After 18 months of study, Chhani completed her training as an auxiliary nurse midwife, and now works at Anjali Hospital. She plans to also provide health services to her community by phone, and to continue her training so she can provide free care to families in poverty. "It was my dream to be a health worker since the time my family could not afford proper treatments for my father," Chhani said. "I got the opportunity to fulfill my dream from the Lutheran World Federation in Nepal. I realized that it was 'God's grace to me and my dreams."
